Cleveland— May 27, 2022 — Today, The May Dugan Center Senior Service team will reach out to senior residences on the near west side of Cleveland to help low-income seniors maintain a clean and safe home environment.

Personal Care and Household Items have a significant budget impact

For low-income seniors, personal hygiene and household cleaning products can be unaffordable. Costing an average of \$74.00 per month, personal care and household items can be as much as 23% of disposable income.

The May Dugan Center Senior Services Team

The May Dugan Center Senior Services Team includes a Behavioral Health Counselor who specializes in Mental Health services for Older Adults, a bilingual Case Manager, a Senior Wellness Coordinator, and two program assistants. Together these staff offer services that help seniors live active, healthy lives as they age in place in the community.

The May Dugan Center serves over 16,000 annually through six core programs committed to the mission of helping enrich and advance their lives and communities.
